

AIRSIDE OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTION 07 - AIRSIDE SAFETY

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AERODROME MANUAL/ AOI REF(s) -	AOI 07, Section 4 Para. 1				

Revised text to AOI 07, Section 4 (Substance Misuse), paragraph 1 to include a statement on the level of consumption and the requirement for personnel operating airside to inform their line manager if taking medication which could affect their ability to operate:

Additional statement as follows:

“The alcohol limits are set as 35mcg per 100ml of breath alcohol concentration as a maximum. In some regulated area’s this level is much lower and company policies and local practices are in place to test monitor and enforce these limits in these areas. Roles that these limits apply to it is the managers responsibility to communicate this information to the persons in these roles.

Where an individual is taking prescribed medication, be this on a permanent or temporary basis that they feel may affect their ability to operate airside, they should inform their line manager of this. It is the persons responsibility to do this and the manager to asses this information and make informed decisions on the information provided”.
