Concerns have been raised with regards to staff safety when personnel are crossing Airport roads.

Please be aware of the following precautions to be taken prior to crossing:

- Always use designated crossings.
- Pay due care an attention prior to and during crossing.
- Don't be distracted by a mobile device prior to or during the crossing.
- Ensure not to cross in-front or behind large vehicles such as busses, as oncoming vehicles won't be able to see you preparing to cross until it's too late.
- General awareness is crucial when crossing roads to ensure safe passage.

Road crossings are a routine part of everyday life but can become very dangerous if due care an attention isn't taken prior to making a crossing. This is especially the case during the winter months where stopping distances of vehicles may be increased due to road surface, and reduced visibility on darker evenings.
