

**OAN 72/2019 – DAYTIME POWER OUTAGE
AFFECTING STANDS 201-204.**

1.0 SUMMARY

On the afternoon/early evening of Monday 22nd July, there will be a temporary power outage (14:00 – 19:00L) that will affect the FEGP units on Stands 202, 203 and 204 and the EBT charging units on Stand 201. The power outage is required as part of the new Terminal 2 baggage hall construction programme.

2.0 PROGRAMME

- 2.1 All work will take place during the afternoon/ early evening of Monday 22nd July 2019.
- 2.2 The working hours will be 14:00 – 19:00L.

3.0 SCOPE & LOCATION OF WORKS

- 3.1 The work will require the temporary, partial isolation of a Low voltage (LV) panel within the Energy Centre Switchroom, and subsequent installation of a new electrical supply to serve the new Terminal 2 baggage hall.
- 3.2 All work will be located landside within the Energy Centre Switchroom. There will be no physical work taking place on the airfield.

4.0 OPERATIONAL IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 On the afternoon/early evening of Monday 22nd July, between the hours of 14:00 and 19:00L the following items of airfield infrastructure will be unavailable for use;
 - FEGP units on Stands 202, 203 and 204.
 - EBT charging units located on Stand 201.
- 4.2 All affected airfield infrastructure will be returned to service upon completion of works.



- 4.3 Unless operationally required, Airfield Control will avoid allocating aircraft to Stands 202, 203 and 204 whilst the FEGP units are unavailable.
- 4.4 In the event of it being necessary to allocate an aircraft to any of the aforementioned stands whilst the FEGP units are unavailable, Handling Agents will be required to provide mobile Ground Power Units.
- 4.5 Where practicable, the use of the EBT charging units on Stand 201 should be completed by 14:00L and vehicles disconnected from the units prior to the start of the power outage.

5.0 CONSIDERATIONS PRIOR TO START OF WORKS

- 5.1 Prior to the start of works, a check will be carried out to ensure that there are no aircraft parked on Stands 202, 203 or 204 connected to FEGP units. Work will not be permitted to commence until any parked aircraft have either departed or been disconnected from the FEGP supply.
- 5.2 Again, prior to the start of works, a check will be undertaken to ensure that there are no vehicles connected to the EBT charging units on Stand 201.

6.0 LOW VISIBILITY PROCEDURES (LVP)


- 6.1 Overall, the work has no impact on the airport's ability to operate during periods of low visibility.
