Today, Monday 16th December 2019, is the 'go live' trial for Project Servator for the Airport Police. You should expect to see extra police presence at certain times, in various locations across the terminal.

Servator is Latin for watcher, observer, or preserver. The project's highly visible police deployments aim to deter, detect and disrupt a range of criminal activity, including terrorism. Project Servator is normal police activity and isn't linked to any specific intelligence about a threat.

Officers will arrive at various locations both landside and Airside. These patrols could last for different lengths of time and involve varying numbers of officers. You'll see, as a minimum, uniform and plain-clothes officers, but we might also include officers from other departments such as dog or armed officers, depending on our specific requirements.
