1.0 SUMMARY

- 1.1 Runway 05L-23R will be closed for five consecutive nights in early January to allow for essential maintenance works on the runway, within its strip and on associated northside taxiways. All flight operations will take place on Runway 05R-23L whilst work is in progress.

2.0 PROGRAMME

- 2.1 Work will take place on the nights of Sunday 12th to Thursday 16th January, inclusive.
- 2.2 The nightly working hours will be 22:30 – 06:00L.

3.0 SCOPE & LOCATION OF WORKS

- 3.1 Overall, the five nights of work will include the following tasks;
- Multiple surface repairs along the length of the Runway 05L-23R pavement.
 - Pavement repairs on Taxiway Alpha including final tie-in work for the new Premier access road.
 - A single asphalt pavement repair on Taxiway Juliet-Echo.
 - Routine runway (and strip) maintenance tasks including surface friction assessments, AGL repairs and bolt checks.

4.0 OPERATIONAL IMPLICATIONS**4.1 Runway Operations**

- 4.1.1 During the Runway 05L-23R closure periods (22:30-06:00L) all flight operations will take place on Runway 05R-23L.

4.2 Taxiway Restrictions

- 4.2.1 Taxiway Alpha, between IHP A2 and its junction with Taxiway Bravo will be closed each night that work takes place.
- 4.2.2 Taxiway Juliet-Echo will be closed abeam Stand 9 from circa 02:00 on the morning of Thursday 16th January.

4.3 Aircraft Parking Stand Restrictions

- 4.3.1 Prior to the start of work on Taxiway Juliet-Echo, a night-stopping aircraft is to be parked on Stand 9.
- 4.3.2 An aircraft may be docked on Stands 7 and 11 whilst work is in progress on Taxiway Juliet-Echo, however any subsequent aircraft pushback manoeuvres will not be possible until the taxiway works have been completed.

5.0 LOW VISIBILITY OPERATIONS (LVO)


- 5.1 In the event of forecast low visibility, the night works will be cancelled and Runway 05L-23R will remain open.
- 5.2 In the event of un-forecast reduced visibility conditions (meeting the criteria for LVP Alert) during the Runway 05L-23R closure period when work has begun, the aerodrome will close to flight operations whilst the runway is recovered. An 'AD Closed' NOTAM will be issued in such circumstances.
