As you will be aware the response to Coronavirus, or COVID-19 as it is now also known, continues to develop both nationally and internationally. The current list of higher risk destinations can be found on the Foreign and Commonwealth Office website and the threat to the UK remains at moderate.

Advice on personal protective equipment for specific roles can be found on the Government website, however we would advise all personnel to remain vigilant and maintain good standards of hygiene by washing hands regularly with soap and water (for at least 20 seconds).

In the event of any suspected or reported cases of coronavirus on board an aircraft, or if you are approached by a guest or colleague at the airport site who is displaying any of the following symptoms, please maintain your distance (at least 2m), ask them to stand aside and contact the emergency line on 01332 818555 (ext.3333):

- a cough
- a high temperature
- shortness of breath

You should provide as much information as possible to enable the airport to relay this to Public Health England. You should then follow the advice given to you by the Control Room or Airport Duty Manager as relevant.

It is our priority to ensure that our colleagues, partners and guests feel safe at our airport and we will continue to work with Public Health England to monitor the situation and follow their guidance.
