All drivers using the apron roads, whether on the Central, Central West, East, or West Apron, must ensure they are aware of, and adhere to the maximum speed limits in place, always.

Signs and road markings advising the current, maximum speed limit can be found at various locations throughout the airside road network.

Failing to drive at a designated speed limit is a non-compliance of the Airside Safety Regulation Scheme, resulting in points on your licence, or potentially loss of permit, and a requirement to re-sit the permit at a cost to your company.
